Are you, or have you been involved in domestic abuse?

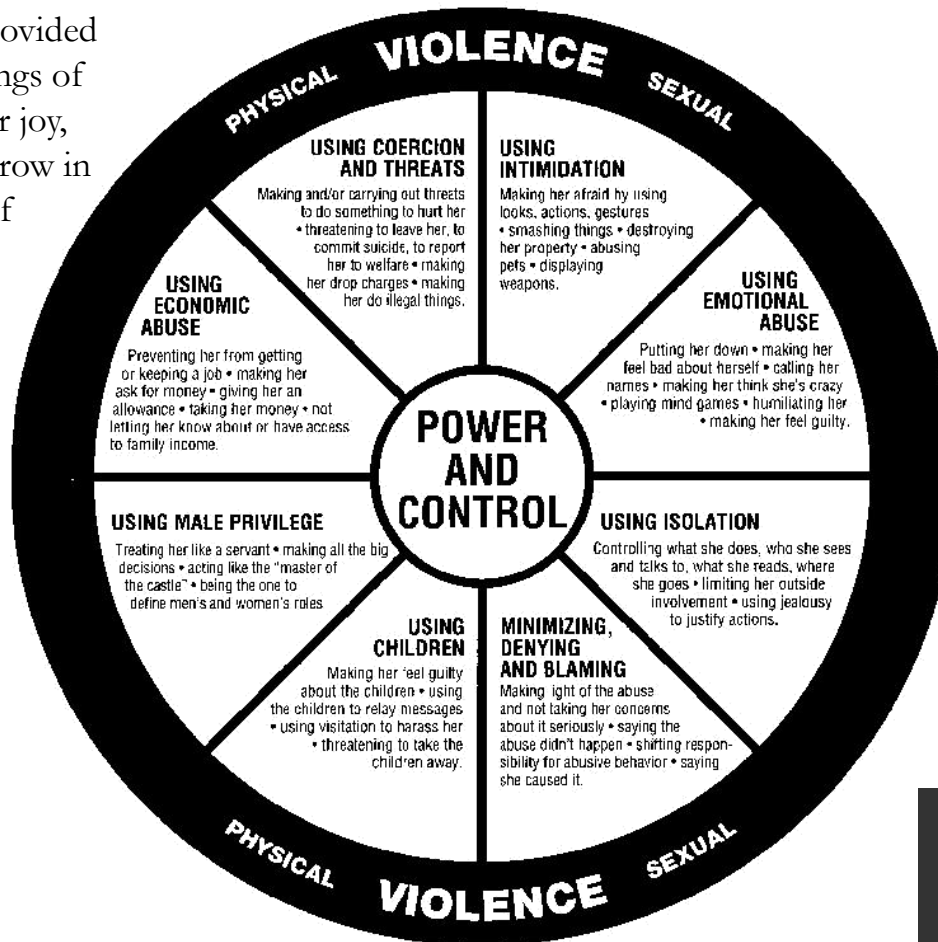
Support groups are a safe &
